Perone, Esq., Chief of Civil Court Programs at the NJ Administrative Office of the Courts, will provide an update on the statewide Judiciary program to assist homeowners in foreclosure actions.

In one of the other featured presentations, **Linda Stamato and Sandy Jaffe**, co-directors of the Center for Negotiation and Conflict Resolution (CNCR) at Rutgers, will present "Public Decision Making, Conflict Management and the CNCR." They will describe how their organization, believing disputes can be settled by constructive negotiation, consensus-building and problem-solving approaches, instead of by force or adversarial argument, serves as a resource both inside and outside New Jersey.
